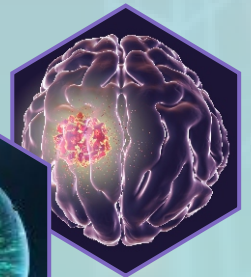
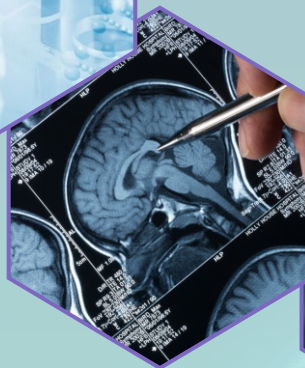

- ✦ **Abstract Template: Title (maximum 25 words)**
  - Name of authors - The name of the presenting author should be underlined
  - Designation
  - Name of Institute
  - Email Address of Author
  - Mobile Number
  - Type of Presentation intended: Poster (Case Report / Case series), Oral Paper
  - Abstract Body: The Abstract should include - Background and Objectives, Methods, Results and Conclusions
- ✦ **Maximum word limit: 300**

- ✦ The last date for submission of abstracts is **10<sup>th</sup> January 2024**
- ✦ All abstracts will be reviewed and confirmation regarding the same will be communicated to delegates by 15<sup>th</sup> January 2024
- ✦ All poster and oral paper presenters will be provided with certificate of presentation
- ✦ Top 3 poster and papers will be awarded.
