- + Topics for poster and oral paper has to be exclusively on Neuropathology
- + Abstract Template: Title (maximum 25 words)
  - Name of authors The name of the presenting author should be underlined
  - Designation
  - > Name of Institute
  - > Email Address of Author
  - > Mobile Number
  - > Type of Presentation intended: Poster (Case Report / Case series), Oral Paper
  - ➤ Abstract Body: The Abstract should include Background and Objectives, Methods, Results and Conclusions
- + Maximum word limit: 300

- + The last date for submission of abstracts is 10<sup>th</sup> January 2024
- ★ All abstracts will be reviewed and confirmation regarding the same will be communicated to delegates by 15<sup>th</sup> January 2024
- → All poster and oral paper presenters will be provided with certificate of presentation
- + Top 3 poster and papers will be awarded.
